EAST VALLEY/WEST RATHDRUM PRAIRIE TRANSPORTATION STUDY PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE, JUNE 6, 2007

Study Purpose: To identify future transportation needs and deficiencies within the Study area based on predicted growth patterns over the next 5-25 years. The Study will include the needs and deficiencies of all modes of travel.

Coordinated Solutions: The Study will propose solutions to transportation needs and deficiencies that are coordinated with all the appropriate jurisdictions and the public input.

Study Area Boundaries:

The west end of the Rathdrum Prairie to Spokane Valley, which generally covers the urban area boundaries below (**map on backside**):

- **Western boundary- Highway 41 in Post Falls and**
- **Eastern boundary- Sullivan Road in Spokane Valley**
- **Northern boundary- S.R. 290 (Trent Avenue) to**
- **Southern boundary- the ridge along Mica Peak.**

Agencies Participating in the Study: City of Post Falls, Post Falls Highway District, Idaho Transportation Department, Spokane County, City of Spokane Valley, City of Liberty Lake, and Washington State Department of Transportation
