3. Approval of December 20, 2016 Meeting Minutes

Chair Jump ask if there were any additions or modifications to the December 20, 2016 minutes that were included in the committee packet. There being none, the minutes were approved as submitted.

4. Public Comments

Mr. Bill Irving representing himself from Climate Action CdA, expressed concerns to the committee related to the transportation systems contribution to climate change and specifically global warming and the communities responsibility to act responsibly to address this issue.

5. Project, Transit & Utility Updates

Bill Roberson, ITD, reported the signal projects on US 95 at Ironwood Drive and Emma Avenue were expected to go this spring. The FY18 sealcoat project has been advanced and will be completed this year; the project includes a section of SH 57, SH 54, and Northwest Boulevard to Sherman Avenue. ITD is currently working on the scope for a number of access improvements along US 95 from Interstate 90 to Highway 53; a consultant has not been selected. Safety improvements will be done at I-90 interchanges 34, 39, and 40. The access management study from the Washington state line to Sherman Avenue is nearly complete. They would also be having meetings at ITD on the 129,000 lbs, truck routes at ITD

Rob Palus, City of Post Falls, noted projects continued to be in winter shut-down; they are working on a Pavement Cut Policy; and updating the Seltice Way Congestion Mitigation Project PS&E in order to go out to bid this fall.

Eric Shanley, Lakes Highway District, noted that people should expect some load limits to be placed with the warming weather, and they will be working on Ohio-Match and Perimeter Road rehabilitations this year.

Kelly Brownsberger, Post Falls Highway District, reported the roundabout project at the intersection of Prairie and Chase Roads and the Three Forks Road projects are expected to go out to this year. There will also be an overlay of Huetter Road.

Alan Soderling, City of Hayden, reported the Ramsey Road Extension project was still temporarily on hold due to the coordination efforts between the airport, County, and the City on the alignment. They are deferring Hayden Avenue project to U.S. 95 to FY 2018. The City will be doing sealcoat projects this summer which include Woodland Meadows and Government Way from Prairie to Hayden Avenue.

David Callahan, Kootenai County, had no updates to report.

Chris Bosley, City of Coeur d'Alene, reported the Seltice Way project will be out to bid and the project is from Huetter Road to Northwest Boulevard and will begin this spring. The Government Way project from Hanley to Prairie Avenue is awaiting approval of a final agreement and the go out to bid. He indicated the City is also updating their Trails and Bike Plan over the next several months.

John Pankratz, Eastside Highway District, indicated they would be seeking Federal Lands Access grant funding for Yellowstone Trail Road through BLM, USFS and FEMA because of its importance as an alternate route for I-90.

Chair Kevin Jump, City of Rathdrum, reported the City was still in winter maintenance getting ready to do some utility relocations.

Jeremy Hofer, Kootenai Electric, reported they will be doing Capital Project 331 – Ramsey Road rebuild from Scarcello to Brunner (3 miles) and in FY 2018 a Scarcello Substation. They will also be doing 22 FEMA related projects.

Jason Stippich, Avista, reported they will be working on a number of subdivisions and miscellaneous road projects. He commented on the high pressured gas main going in along Prairie Avenue.

Ralph Paul, IDEQ, had no updates to report.

The transit update will be provided under Agenda Item 6.a.

No other utilities were present.

a. Bike/Pedestrian Safety Workshop Update May 23-24 – Ali Marienau

Ali Marienau provided the committee with an overview of the NHI Courses on Pedestrian and Bicycle safety that will take place in May. Glenn Miles indicated that Ali would be taking the lead on setting up the training and the Regional Bike Ped Plan update.
