## KMPO 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #15, Administrative Modification to Include STP Urban funding increases to two Projects: KN 12308 and KN 13864

KMPO has been requested by the Idaho Transportation Department and LHTAC to approve an increase funding for two currently programmed projects. Government Way – Hanley to Prairie is a current year project for 2017 that was substantially over the engineers estimate when it went out to bid. This increase will help support funding for the new Engineers estimate. The Meyer Road & Boekel Road Intersection project is in Preliminary Development requiring additional funds in order to award the negotiated engineering and design contract. In both cases, this amendment will be to obligate funds in the FY 2017 Program year.
