KMPO 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #10, Administrative Amendment to reallocate funding within existing Strategic Initiatives Program for SH-41 Corridor Projects KN 20098 and 2012 to increase FY 2017 funding for Engineering and Design activities.

KMPO has been requested by the Idaho Transportation Department to amend a project currently programmed in the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the FY 2017 for projects scheduled for construction in program year 2021. Increase Engineering and Design Funds for SH-41 Lancaster to Boekel Road by \$290,000 and SH-41, Prairie Ave to Lancaster Road by \$290,000 in FY 2017.
