KMPO 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #5, Administrative Amendment to increase Design and Engineering funds for 2 ITD projects in FY 2017

KMPO has been requested by the Idaho Transportation Department to modify 2 projects currently programmed in the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the FY 2019 program year, having their Design and Engineering funds increased in FY 2017. Those projects are:

ITD will certify that funds are currently available within the Federal Aid program for FY 2017 in order to obligate the funds from the Federal Highway Administration.

The Kootenai Metropolitan Planning Organization, approves this Administrative Amendment to increase the PC amounts for KN 19326 \$55,000 and KN 19385 \$65,000 in order to conduct the increased activities associated with the project.
