## KMPO 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #9, Administrative Amendment to reallocate and increase PC funding levels for project KN 19452 U.S. 95, "IC #430 to La Crosse Ave., CdA

KMPO has been requested by the Idaho Transportation Department to amend a project currently programmed in the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the FY 2017 and FY 2021 program years, having Planning (PC) funds for KN 13423 FHWA and FTA consolidated in FY 2017 by \$253,676; reduce KN 13238 in 2021 to \$66,891 and Increase Engineering and Design Funds for SH-41 Lancaster Intersection(2020) by \$50,000 in FY 2017.
