KMPO 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #13,

KMPO is administratively amending the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program to reflect a separation of the pathway project previously included in the project scope of work into a separate project key number (KN22157). This is being accomplished by deleting current and FY 2019 program year funding for PC in the amount of \$210,000 from KN 20352 and deleting \$2,100,000 in FY 2019 Construction in funding for KN20795. The project and funding is currently within the existing 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program and does not impact fiscal constraint, nor does it modify the existing scope of the project, but further defines the scope and budget for the trail project.
