KN 19883 U.S. 95, North Corridor Access Project

KMPO 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #2, and KMPO 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #17, Modifying existing project KN 19883 to increase funding levels by \$2 million in Safety Program funds.

KMPO is administratively amending the 2018 and 2019 Transportation Improvement Program to modify the fiscal year 2019 - U.S. 95, North Corridor Access project by increasing the Total Project funding by \$2,000,000 from the ITD State Safety Program. The project will provide for ADA improvements in areas within the corridor not already covered by the existing grant. The project is currently within the existing 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program and does not impact fiscal constraint, nor does it significantly modify the existing scope of the project.
