SUBJECT: 2017-2021 KMPO TIP **Amendment #11** ITD Request for Administrative Modification to Adjust Engineering and Design funding levels in two projects.

KMPO 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #11, Administrative Amendment to reallocate funding within existing Strategic Initiatives Program for SH-41 Corridor Projects KN 19471 and for KN 19883 to increase FY 2017 funding for Engineering and Design activities, and reduce right of way as an offset within the project

KMPO has been requested by the Idaho Transportation Department to amend a project currently programmed in the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the FY 2017 for projects scheduled for construction in program year 2020 and 2018. Increase Engineering and Design Funds for SH-41 Lancaster Intersection by \$100,000 and the U.S. 95 North Corridor Access Improvements Fastlane by \$650,000 in FY 2017.
