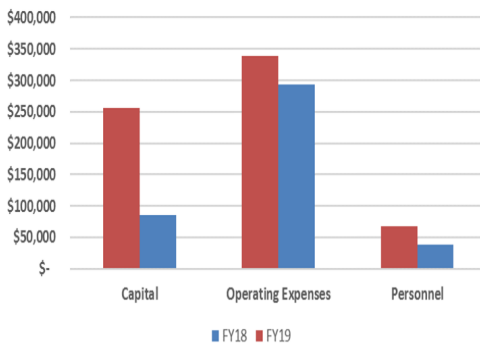
Paratransit/Ring-a-Ride Feb 2019:
