 SUBJECT: 2019-2025 KMPO TIP **Amendment #6** Revising CN Funding down \$100,000 to \$288,000 and adding Right of Way funding same amount for KN 19749 Riverview Drive Guardrail Installation – Post Falls Highway District

KMPO 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #6: Revising current funding within the existing project to accommodate right of way acquisition as the result of a change during design. Federal Aid Funding for construction reduced by \$100,000 to \$288,000 and funding for right of way acquisition adding \$100,000. Total project cost remains the same.

KMPO is administratively amending the 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program to decrease construction costs (CN) in the amount of \$100,000 in order to cover right of way acquisition costs. ITD will certify that funds are currently available in order to obligate funds to this programmed project in the FY 2019 program year.
