 SUBJECT: 2019-2025 KMPO TIP Amendment #21 revising and increasing funding levels for Utilities (UT), Design and Engineering (PC), and Acquire Right of Way with FY 2019 funding

KMPO 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #21 Revising **Key Number(s) 12315, 18716, and 20038**. This amendment requested by ITD/LHTAC increases KN 12315 by \$16,000 for Utilities, Increase KN 18716 in design and engineering levels by \$50,000 in Federal Bridge (Local) funding, and Increases KN20038 RW Land Purchase by \$90,000. KMPO is administratively amending the 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program to revise the funding level as described, and as approved by the ITD. ITD certifies funds are STP – Local Rural Program and Bridge – Local Program to support the additional funding identified within this amendment.
