KMPO 2019-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #16

NOTE: Amendment #16 was assigned in July 2019 to the Kootenai County Application for Section 5339 funds, in the event it was approved by the KMPO Board. This amendment also incorporates modifications requested to the 2019 Program subsequent to that date.

1. Revising **Key Number: NEW KEY NUMBER** This amendment incorporates a KMPO Board approved new project to the program, which will construct two new transit shelter locate on the City Link fixed route bus service. One located at the Panhandle Health District and a second located in the vicinity of Seltice Way and Huetter Roads. This project application received a 30 public comment period prior to KMPO Board action. The funding identified within this amendment comes from FTA Section 5339 Small Urban funds and is available for programming and obligation.

This project is located near the City of Coeur d' Alene in Kootenai County and consists of funding to construct a 2 inch overlay, new pavement markings and additional safety features including signs and guardrail, when appropriate, to provide significant improvements to the safety and conditions of this road.

1. Revising **Key Numbers 20794 and 20795** This amendment requested by ITD reallocates both GARVEE and Bridge Restoration Funding between the two (2) linked projects that remove and replace the old Union Pacific Bridge on SH-53 and grade separates U.S. 95 from SH-53 and Garwood Roads. This amendment <u>moves \$7,000,000 in GARVEE from 20794 to 20795</u>, while <u>moving \$6,000,000 in Bridge Restoration funds from 20795 to 20794</u>.
