SUBJECT: 2020-2026 KMPO TIP Amendment #2 adding Federal Lands Access Program Projects

KN 20775 Yellowstone Trail Road, MP 1.9 to 2.1 Slide Repair and KN 22607 Yellowstone Trail

Road Improvements Segment 1, Part 2.

The Kootenai Metropolitan Planning Organization (KMPO) received notification from the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) that East Side Highway District was selected to receive competitive funding through the Western Federal Lands Highway Division's Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) for continued road improvements on the Yellowstone Trail Road located east of Coeur d' Alene, ID . This notification addresses two (2) projects. KN 20775 provides additional funds (\$2,000,000) to a previously programmed project for slide repair, and KN 22607 for reconstruction within the existing project area to address current safety deficiencies with a wider road and roadside safety measures in the amount of \$5,880,000.

The 2020-2026 Transportation Improvement Program **Amendment #2** provides for an administrative amendment for these two safety related projects that have been selected by Federal Highway Administrations Western Federal Lands competitive grant program. Both projects are a continuation of an existing project to improve safety deficiencies.
