Federal Safety Funds (local) and \$300,000 in Local Funding

The Kootenai Metropolitan Planning Organization (KMPO) has been requested by Post Falls Highway District and LHTAC to add \$235,000 in Federal Safety funding and \$300,000 in local participating funding to support construction of the Pleasant View and Prairie Avenue intersection improvements.

The Pleasant View Rd and Prairie Ave Intersection Improvements project is located near Post Falls in Kootenai County and will improve the incidence of angle injury accidents and will help eliminate the continued occurrence of accidents with the reduction/elimination of serious injury crashes and fatalities. Amendment #13 adds \$235,000 in Federal Safety (local) and \$300,000 in Local Participating funds.

This amendment does not affect the projects anticipated impact on safety performance measures, and is supported by Post Falls Highway District and the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC). LHTAC and Post Falls Highway District certify they have sufficient funds in the program to support the increase within this Administrative Amendment.
