SUBJECT: 2021-2027 KMPO TIP **Amendment #21** Request to increase funding for one FY 2022 project **KN21938** U.S. 95 – Ironwood to SH-53 into the FY 2022 Program Year.

This project was added to the FY 2022 program year as a result of ITD Board action in September. This request is to increase construction funding in the amount of \$325,418. This necessitates an amendment to the currently active FY 2021Transportation Improvement Program FY 2022 program year. The funding source for the amendment is derived from currently programmed funds, as well as State funds identified from Statewide Program fund balancing by ITD.
