SUBJECT: 2022-2028 KMPO TIP **Amendment #1** Request to modify the FY 2022 program year to increase funding for KN 21935 CdA River Bridge East and West Bound lanes Restoration.

This amendment is to add \$360,000 to KN 21935 CdA River Bridge East and West Bound for additional PE/PC. This necessitates an amendment to the currently active FY 2022-2028Transportation Improvement Program FY 2022 program year. The funding source for the amendment is derived from offsets from KN2797 and KN 20678.
