SUBJECT: 2022-2028 KMPO TIP **Amendment #3** Request to modify the FY 2022 program year to revise and add funding for PL on project KN19682 SH-41 Mullan Ave to Prairie Ave.

This amendment adds \$110,000 in Right of Way funds for KN 19682, SH-41 Mullan Ave to Prairie Ave into the FY 2022 program year. This necessitates an amendment to the currently active FY 2022-2028 Transportation Improvement Program FY 2022 program year from available ITD sources.
