SUBJECT: 2022-2028 KMPO TIP **Amendment #13** ITD Request to modify the FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program by increasing three projects **KN 20795** U.S. 95 Garwood Road Grade Separation and Frontage Roads \$1,000,000, **KN 20098** SH-41 E Prairie Ave to Boekel Rd \$300,000, and **KN 20641** SH-53 Ramsey Road Intersection \$300,000.

This amendment provides additional funding to previously programmed and obligated projects for utility and construction related activities. The KN 20795 increase is related to additional utility and construction costs. The additional costs are being offset from another previously programmed project KN 20788. The KN 20098 increase is for additional utility related costs and is being funded through the ITD Statewide Balancing process using available funds. The KN20641SH-53, Ramsey Road Intersection is for additional utility work funded through Statewide Balancing. This necessitates an amendment to the currently active FY 2022-2028 Transportation Improvement Program FY 2022 program year.
