SUBJECT: 2023-2029 KMPO TIP Amendment 3 Request by ITD on KN 20645 to increase construction funding by \$500,000

The Idaho Transportation Department is requesting an amendment to the 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment increases construction (CN) funding by \$500,000 in State funding to cover a change order to address work on the associated storm water system. Funding will be provided from the Statewide Balance of Leading Idaho Funds.

This project will reconstruct the median on I 90 between milepost 32 and 36 in order to install concrete barrier in the median. The installation of this barrier will increase the safety of the Interstate by providing positive separation between the eastbound and westbound travel lanes to reduce head-on collisions by traffic crossing the median into opposing traffic.

The 2023-2029 Transportation Improvement Program **Amendment 3** provides for the amendment by Administrative Modification where the does not materially change the design, concept, or scope of the original project, and conforms to approved existing plans and programs These projects have been through the required and concluded public involvement processes prior to their original obligation, and ITD certifies by their submission to KMPO for amendment to the current 2023 program year, that sufficient funds are available for obligation in the Leading Idaho Program. Based on the representation by ITD, the Kootenai Metropolitan Planning Organization, approves **Amendment #3** effective February 27, 2023.
