SUBJECT: 2023-2029 KMPO TIP **Amendment 5** Request by ITD on **KN 20098** to increase construction funding by \$150,000 and **KN 20575** Additional Construction \$450,000

The Idaho Transportation Department is requesting an amendment to the 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment increases construction (CC) funding for two projects. **KN 20098 SH 41, E Prairie Ave to Boekel Rd., Kootenai Co**, an additional \$150,000 in Federal NHS funding to cover additional construction related costs and **KN 20575 SH-53, Hauser Lake Rd to N Bruss Rd** an additional \$450,000 in HSIP – State Funding for close-out. Funding has been approved from the Statewide Balancing process.
