SUBJECT: 2023-2029 KMPO TIP **Amendment #16** Request by LHTAC on **KN 18716** increase Construction ((CN) funding \$ 808,749

The Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) is requesting an amendment to the 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment increases \$808,749 in Bridge - Local Construction Funding (CN) **KN 18716 Spokane Street River Bridge**. Funding to support the amendment is a transfer of \$808,749 from unscheduled Local Bridge Funds to the Construction Phase to match the current engineers estimate.
