SUBJECT: 2025-2031 KMPO TIP **Amendment # 14** ITD request to increase **KN 23243 I-90 Wolf Lodge to Cedars Maintenance Site** in the FY 2025-2031 Transportation Improvement Program by increasing the project CE in the amount of \$ 200,000 in Interstate Maintenance funds.

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is requesting modification to the approved 2025-2031 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment increases CD funding for KN 23243 in the amount of \$200,000 in Interstate Maintenance to cover cost overruns and additional expenditures. This funding is being offset from the Statewide balance.
