SUBJECT: 2025-2031 KMPO TIP **Amendment # 15** ITD request to increase **KN 24398 Prairie Trail Underpass and KN 12310 Ramsey Road Extension** increasing each project in the amount of \$ 200,000 in STP Large Urban, End of the Year funding. KN 24162 SH-53 increases \$150,000 for Preliminary Engineering (PE).

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is requesting modification to the approved 2025-2031 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment increases funding for KN 24398 in the amount of \$200,000 for Construction (CN) and KN 12310 in the amount of \$200,00 for Land Purchase (LP) using STBG Large Urban End of the Year programming funds. This funding is from FHWA FY 2025 Redistribution Funding provided to the Statewide balance. KN 24162 Increases \$150,000 for an environmental/cultural resource agreement, offset from the Statewide Balance.
